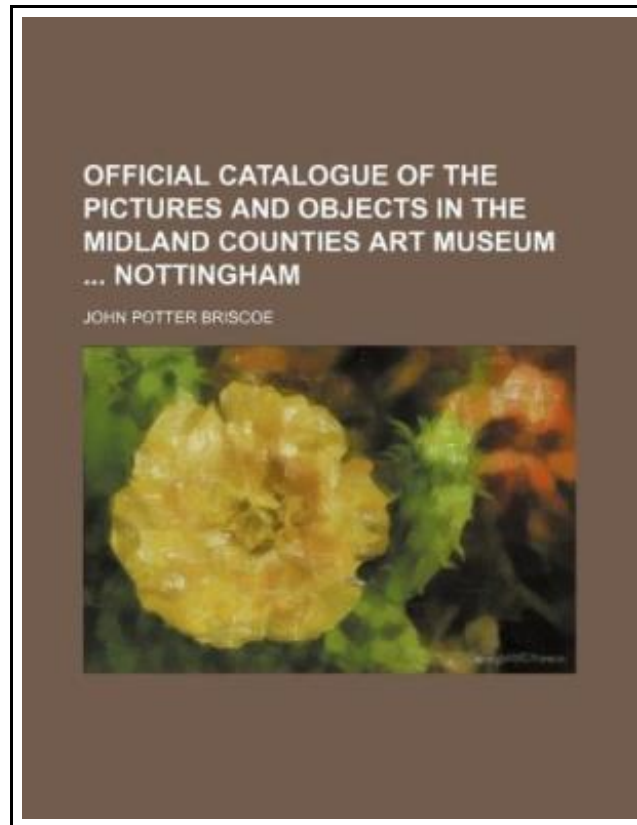

The terms have reference to the composition as well as to the degree of heat to which it is exposed in the furnace. Thus, common brick is soft; fire-brick, hard. Common earthenware vessels are soft; crockery, such as stone ware, is hard. Porcelain is also distinguished by the technical terms soft and hard paste, the softness being determined by the greater proportion of silex. Porcelain is composed of two substances; the one fusible which produces its transparency, the other infusible. The best practical test to distinguish the two descriptions is that the body of the soft paste can be scratched with a knife, which is not the case with hard paste. The ancient pottery of Egypt, Greece, and Rome was soft; whether glazed, unglazed, or lustrous. In our own days oriental porcelain may be taken as a type of hard, and early Sevres or Chelsea of soft paste manufacture.
