I have therefore used the wider term Mycology, in preference to Bacteriology, as the title of the present work. Bacteriology has developed to such an extent that at the present time some fifteen hundred organisms have been described and a large proportion of them are to be met with occasionally in the mouth. It is impossible to include in the scope of the present work, all the bacteria found from time to time in the oral fluids, especially as environment, food, dust and other causes determine to a great extent the species of the buccal flora; at the same time a certain number of organisms, many of them well known to bacteriologists in other situations, are so frequently found that they deserve consideration as mouth bacteria; a few bacteria and some higher forms related to the Hyphomycetes are to be found in the mouth only, I have therefore included in...
